Advanced Studies vs. Standard Diploma

- **26 Credits**

English - 4 credits

Social Studies - 4 credits

Math - 4 credits

Science - 4 credits

Health/PE - 2 credits

World Language - 3 credits in one language or 2 credits each in two different languages

Economics/ Finance – 1 credit

Fine/performing or CTE - 1 credit

Electives - 3 credits

- **22 Credits**

English - 4 credits

Social Studies - 4 credits

Math - 3 credits

Science - 3 credits

Health/PE - 2 credits

World Language, Fine Arts, or CTE – 2 credits

Economics/ Finance – 1 credit

Electives - 3 credits (must include 2 sequential electives)



Verified Credits

For **both** Advanced Studies **and** Standard Diploma **5 verified credits** are required in the following areas:

- Reading
- Writing
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies



Credits vs. Verified Credits

Credits - Passing the *class* will allow you to earn a credit.

Verified Credits - Passing the class **AND** passing the SOL attached to the class.



Industry Certification

- Required for a Standard Diploma
- Can be earned through tests in CTE courses and/or Finance Course

Honors/AP Classes

- Honors/AP classes are designed for students who wish to accelerate their high school course of study to include courses that may be taken for college credit. Honors/AP courses are ***faster paced*** classes that ***require in-depth analysis and synthesis of subject matter***. Students attempting an Honors/AP class at the high school level should have ***strong study habits***.
- Admission to Honors/AP courses will not be denied; however, parents and students should be aware of the nature of these courses and that ***inadequate preparation for Honors/AP level course content may limit a student's success in the course***. Students should be prepared to accept ***rigorous course requirements***.ool level should have ***strong study habits***.
