WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

BENEFITS OF DUAL ENROLLMENT

- Allows students to take college courses while still in high school.
- Provides a wider range of course options for high school students.
- Eliminates the need to take the same course in high school and college.
- Allows high school students to move towards their next academic goal without having to wait until high school graduation.

BENEFITS OF DUAL ENROLLMENT

- Allows high school students to earn college credits that may apply toward graduation at Lord Fairfax Community College or another college or university.
- Shortens the time required for students to complete an undergraduate degree.
- Increase flexibility at a four-year school and may provide opportunities for semester-long internships, work-study experiences and/or double major
- Lowers the cost for a post-secondary education.

WHERE DO I TAKE MY CLASSES?

- Most students will take all of their dual enrollment courses at the high school during the regular school day.
- Students also have the option to take courses on the LFCC Middletown campus during the evenings and over the summer.

GOVERNOR'S SCHOLAR

■ What is a Governor's Scholar?

Students who earn college credits in high school through Dual Enrollment and/or AP credits may be able to obtain the following credentials through LFCC before they graduate from high school:

- Certificate in General Education
- Associate of Arts and Sciences Degree
- Associate of Science Degree

Students who complete any of these credentials are designated as **GOVERNOR'S SCHOLARS**.

BENEFITS OF GOVERNOR'S SCHOLAR

- Shows colleges that you are an exceptional student who is ready for college classes
- Shortens the time required to complete an undergraduate degree
- Increases flexibility at a four-year school and may provide opportunities for semester-long internships, work or study abroad experiences, double majors or additional minors
- May provide scholarship opportunities with four-year schools based on successful completion of college courses
- Lowers the cost for a post-secondary education
- Allows you to add a college credential to your resume

DUAL ENROLLMENT VS. AP CREDIT

	Dual Enrollment	AP
Type of course/curriculum	college course	college preparatory course
Where is the course offered?	high school and/or college	high school
Who teaches?	high school teachers/college professors	high school teachers
Transfer to 4-year institution	Course grade of “C” or better accepted by nearly all VA 4-year schools; outside of VA depends on individual transfer policies and degree requirements	Must take AP Exam at the completion of the course; LFCC accepts “3” or higher most 4 year schools look for a “4” or higher
Cost	\$36.56 per credit hour	\$93 per exam

- Take required placement tests
- Register/pay for courses in August

- Meet with Career Coach to determine testing requirements
- Take required placement tests (if applicable)
- Register/pay for courses in August

- Testing will be offered at Millbrook High School:
 - April 18
 - May 16
 - June 6
 - June 7
- Testing begins promptly at 2:45 pm in the Library Computer Lab.
- LFCC Application **MUST** be completed prior to testing.
- Students must reserve a seat for testing as space is limited. See the Career Coach to reserve your seat.
