 - *National Honor Society Members
 - *Volunteer participation in the community
 - *Applicants in multiple business classes
 - *Participation in business internships or work experience
 - *Participation in additional clubs
 - *Participation in community civic clubs
 - *NONE OF THE ABOVE IS REQUIRED

Submissions will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Creativity of overall application/presentation (25%)
- Essay (20%)
- Community Involvement (15%)
- Academic performance (10%)
- Recommendations (10%)
- Business club involvement (10%)
- Subjective (10%)
