Dual Enrollment Overview



What is Dual Enrollment?

Dual enrollment is a program which allows students to enroll in specific courses and earn high school and college credit simultaneously.

At Millbrook, **Dual Enrollment** credit is awarded through Lord Fairfax Community College (LFCC)



Dual Enrollment Overview



What are the benefits of Dual Enrollment?

- Lowers the cost for postsecondary education
- May shorten time to complete a degree
- Provides a wider range of course options for high school students
- Earn credit for both high school and college (LFCC) at the same time
- Introduces and prepares students for college coursework
- Classes taken at Millbrook are offered at a discounted rate, *75% less than the current LFCC tuition price!*



Dual Enrollment Overview



How are these courses taught?

- The course is taught by a credentialed high school instructor at our high school

What classes are available?

- Many courses are available, including a variety of Math, English, Science, Social Studies, Foreign Language and more

When these courses taught?

- During the regular school day (primarily)
- Evenings (LFCC)
- Online (at student convenience)

Are Dual Enrolled Classes Guaranteed to Transfer to a Four Year University?

Dual Enrollment classes are **NOT** guaranteed to transfer to a four year university.

Dual Enrollment Versus AP Exam

dual enroll course through



STEPS:

1. Apply online to LFCC
2. Take LFCC placement test(s) **before** course to determine college readiness to dual enroll
3. Submit LFCC registration forms and tuition payments
4. Obtain "C" or better in course to transfer credit to **most** four-year colleges and universities

Students **DO NOT** have to take the AP Exam at the end of the course in order to receive LFCC college credit



AP CLASS

take for HS credit only



STEPS:

No further action required for students who do not seek college credit for the class

take the AP Exam through



STEPS:

1. Sign up to take AP Exam with Millbrook's Accountability Specialist and pay exam fee
2. Take AP Exam
3. Achieve a score of "4" or "5" to receive transfer credit for **most** four-year colleges and universities.

Students **MUST** take AP Exam at the end of the course **and** achieve required score for four-year college/universities in order to receive college credit

This diagram is intended to illustrate how students in the same class can complete the course with a variety of educational goals and objectives. Further questions about the difference between Dual Enrollment and the Advanced Placement Exam can be answered by the Career Coach, Mrs. Post.

Apply to Lord Fairfax Community College

Apply directly to Lord Fairfax Community College

- Go to www.lfcc.edu and click “Apply Today”
- Choose “High School Dual Enrolling for the First Time”
- Follow Instructions

Step 1

Helpful Tips

- The first step of the application is just creating an account. Your Application is not complete until you receive a student ID number
- You will need to provide an email to set up your account that you can access immediately - they will send a code to that email.
- Use your full legal name. No nicknames!
- Choose “Middletown Campus”
- Write down your LFCC student ID number, username and password
